



Pedorthic Practicum Bursary

The Pedorthic Practicum Bursary is awarded to deserving students who are enrolled in the Western University – Continuing Studies, Pedorthics (Diploma) Program and are relocating to participate in one of three practicums. This bursary is intended to provide financial support for students who would like to gain Pedorthic experience in another city or province. This bursary is generously supported by the Pedorthic Association of Canada.

Value: 5 bursaries granted annually, \$2000 per practicum.

Eligibility: To be eligible to receive the bursary you must;

- Be enrolled full-time at Western University – Continuing Studies, Pedorthics Diploma Program
- Secure a practicum that requires you to relocate
 - Successful applicants will be provided with a conditional approval of funding prior to the beginning of their practicum
 - Confirmation of the secured practicum must be provided by the practicum supervisor before funds will be transferred to the recipient

Note: Those who commute from their permanent residence to a practicum will not be eligible to receive this bursary.
